CLASS 4A ONLY - 2008-09 SEEDING/BYE PLAN FORMAT

Sub-state assignments will be made by the IHSAA as in previous years and will be released on the IHSAA web site. Sub-state sites will be selected by the IHSAA and teams will be seeded in each predetermined sub-state, 6 teams in each sub-state.

1 seed VS 6 seed

2 seed VS 5 seed

3 seed VS 4 seed

In the second round, the highest winning first round seed will receive the bye. The lowest seeded winners will play each other in the sub-state second round. In the sub-state final, the team receiving the bye plays the winner of second round game. Seeding will be as follows:

Victory over a 4A Iowa school 4 points

Victory over a 3A Iowa school 3 points

Victory over a 2A Iowa school 2 points

Victory over a 1A Iowa school 1 point

Seeding is based on the school's record against Iowa High School varsity teams. Any varsity games played against out of state opponents, will not count toward seeding, but will count against the overall win/loss record.

This will be a 2 year experiment starting officially in 2008.
