Nominations Welcomed

*Hall of Fame members are elected annually from nominations received from our member schools. Interested fans and media should contact a potential candidate's high school and enjoy that administrator in the nomination. The IHSAA provides the school with the nomination form. Nomination should contain the athlete's name, high school attended, year of graduation, high school achievements (all-state honors, state leader, etc.); post high school achievements; and current address and telephone number. They should be mailed to Bud Legg; Iowa High School Athletic Association; PO Box 10; Boone, IA 50036. The selection committee meets each spring. **Nominations must be on file by April 1 of each year.** Candidates are not eligible until 10 years after their high school graduation date, but can be nominated any time. Nominated candidates who are not selected remain under consideration for subsequent years.*

NOTE: Football Coaches' Hall of Fame selections are made by the Iowa High School Football Coaches Association.
