

Student Leadership Conference Set for October

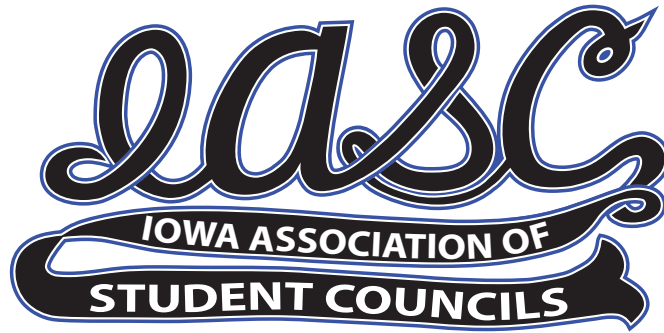
The Iowa Association of Student Councils (IASC) is partnering once again with the Iowa High School Athletic Association for the upcoming Iowa Student Leadership Conference on Sunday, October 30 and Monday, October 31 at the Iowa Events Center.

Featured on TV, radio, and in newspapers, Scott Backovich, an international youth motivational speaker, will give the keynote address for attendees.

The IASC fall conference is a great way for high school and junior high student leaders to connect and learn new ideas on how to become even better leaders in their schools. This conference is NOT just for student council members, but for any high school and junior high students in leadership positions.

On Sunday evening students will network with other students from across the state as they take part in leadership activities and finish the evening with a community service activity.

The conference gets in full swing on Monday morning as the keynote

will focus on how each student has the power to influence their world through passion and determination.

During the general session, various awards will be presented, the state project will be introduced, and new state officers will be announced.

Students will then be able to select break-out leadership sessions from a menu of choices. Break-out sessions will center on school improvement, leadership development, fundraising, appreciation, character building, community service, and school spirit.

registration materials either Sunday evening at 6:30 pm or Monday from 8:30 – 9:00 am. Schools may choose to eat lunch wherever they want.
