

REFEREE'S SIGN OFF SHEET

When using TrackWrestling, or any other electronic system, to score a wrestling dual meet or tournament there is no scorebook or final bout sheet for the referee to sign as required by NFHS rule 3.1.11. Because the Athletic Association is promoting the use of TrackWrestling there needs to be another way for the referee to certify the results and record the time the meet ended. This sheet will serve that purpose. For dual meets, the referee should sign this sheet and give it to the official scorer or host athletic director in the same manner he/she would sign the scorebook. For tournaments, the referee can continue to sign the final meet results that would include the team scores, or use this sheet. The host, or home, school can fill in the appropriate information and have this sheet ready to sign when the meet is completed. The host, or home school, should keep this signed form as part of their records.
