EMERGENCY ACTION PLANNING CHEMICAL SPILL / ATTACK WHILE ON A BUS

The coach/advisor should:

- 1. remain calm
- 2. remain in the bus with doors and windows closed
- 3. have students cover their nose and mouth with handkerchief or other material
- 4. contact 911
- 5. take attendance and make certain all participants and other personnel are present
- 6. attempt to locate anyone missing; determine their last known location
- 7. contact the activities director, superintendent, principal and/or transportation director
- 8. report any missing person to the fire department, law enforcement or rescue team
- 9. await further instructions from emergency personnel
- 10. follow school protocol regarding media contact
- 11. follow school protocol for releasing students to parents/guardians

The activities director / event manager should:

- 1. assess the situation
- 2. contact 911, if not already done
- 3. communicate and cooperate with emergency personnel
- 4. be sure coaches/advisors have taken attendance and accounted for all team personnel
- 5. be sure superintendent, principal and/or transportation director have been contacted
- 6. follow school protocol regarding media contact
- 7. follow school protocol for releasing students and informing parents
- 8. contact the AD from the opposing school to inform him/her of the situation and reschedule the contest.
