RULES & REGULATIONS

Pricing applies to access for any television broadcast that originates from an over-the-air, community cable, regional cable, or other related channel [Examples: Mediacom 22, Cedar Falls Channel 15, KCRG 9.2, NBC Sports Chicago, etc.], and/or Internet broadcasts that post, stream, or webcast video with audio in any way [Examples: CISN.tv, MaxPreps, QCTimes.com, Facebook Live, Periscope, etc.]. There is no charge for rebroadcasting or retransmitting events which have already received approved broadcasting access.

APPLICATIONS: Must be submitted to IHSAA office and postseason host site manager at least 48 hours in advance of the scheduled start time of the selected event. The 2019-20 form can be found [HERE](#).

FEES: Baseball, basketball, football, and soccer are priced per game. Golf, swimming, tennis, and wrestling are priced per day. Bowling, cross country, and track and field currently hold co-ed events are not available for broadcast at this time.
