ALCOHOL, TOBACCO POLICY

 \cap

No alcohol or tobacco (including vapor and e-cigarettes) are to be sold or consumed on the grounds of any tournament venue leased or provided to the Athletic Association/Athletic Union for the purpose of conducting a State Championship Series event. A person violating this policy is subject to penalties pursuant to **Iowa Code Section 805.8C(3)**.

Section 123.46 of the lowa Code States: A person shall not possess or consume alcoholic liquors, wine or beer on public school property or while attending a public or private school-related function. A person shall not be intoxicated or simulate intoxication in a public place. A person violating this subsection is guilty of a simple misdemeanor.

CONDUCT COUNTS

In this EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION these behaviors are <u>NOT</u> acceptable:

- Disrespectful conduct, including profanity, obscene gestures or comments, offensive remarks of a sexual nature, or other actions that demean individuals or the event. Penalty - EJECTION
- Throwing articles onto the contest area.
 Penalty EJECTION
- Entering the contest area in protest or celebration. Penalty - EJECTION
- Physical confrontation involving contest officials, coaches/directors, contestants or spectators.
 Penalty - EJECTION
- Spectator interference with the event. Penalty - EJECTION
- Jumping up and down on the bleachers. Penalty - Warning/EJECTION
- Use of artificial noisemakers, signs or banners. Penalty - Warning/EJECTION
- Chants or cheers directed at opponents.
 Penalty Warning/EJECTION

PEGEATOR CONDUCT (Public Conduct on School Premises) IOWA CODE - 716.7 PRO

Individuals disrupting school district activities will be asked to stop the disruption and may be asked to leave the school district grounds, temporarily or permanently.

PETS PROHIBITED at IGHSAU/IHSAA Sanctioned Events

Except as otherwise stated herein, no pets are permitted at events sanctioned by the IGHSAU/IHSAA. Any persons found with a pet at an event will be removed from the premises. However, this policy shall comply with the provisions of Iowa Code 216C. 1. For purposes of this section, "service dog" means a dog specially trained to assist a person with a disability, whether described as a service dog, a support dog, an independence dog, or otherwise. "Assistive animal" means a simian or other animal specially trained or in the process of being trained to assist a person with a disability. 2. A person with a disability, a person assisting a person with a disability by controlling a service dog or an assistive animal, or a person training a service dog or an assistive animal has the right to be accompanied by a service dog or an assistive animal, under control, in any of the places listed in sections 216C.3 and 216C.4 without being required to make additional payment for the service dog or assistive animal. The person is liable for damage done to any premises or facility by a service dog or assistive animal.



The use or possession of unmanned aircraft or aerial systems (UAS), also known as drones, is prohibited for any purpose by any person or entity at any IHSAA/IGHSAU post-season tournament events or venues. An exception to this policy may be granted in writing by the IHSAA/IGHSAU executive director to law enforcement, public safety agencies, IHSAA/IGHSAU media partners, or other entities or individuals.

This prohibition applies to the area above and upon all spectator areas, fields of play, courts, arenas, stadiums, mats, gym floor or pool, practice facilities, parking areas, and includes a ban on the entire facility or property being used as part of the IHSAA/IGHSAU event.

Forpurposes of this policy, a UAS is any unmanned airborne device or aircraft. The IHSAA/IGHSAU reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone possessing, operating, or attempting to operate a UAS or to request the immediate removal of any person using or attempting to use a UAS in violation of this policy.

Regular Season Events

The IHSAA/IGHSAU does not regulate the use of UAS above or upon the property or facilities of member host schools during regular season events.
