Hello,

Members of the media and individuals interested in covering the IHSAA's 2022 winter state tournament events should follow instructions listed below. If you have questions or require accommodations, contact IHSAA communications director Chris Cuellar: ccuellar@iahsaa.org.

A few notes before diving into the state tournament information...

- **Lead-Up Attendance:** All media members should be contacting host school administrators to request attendance and entry prior to arriving at IHSAA events. Sign-in sheets will be available for complimentary entry at postseason lead-up events (district basketball, district wrestling, etc.).
- **Lead-Up Livestreams:** If your outlet is interested in producing video from postseason lead-up events, the IHSAA has a video access procedure in place. Policies, fees, and application forms <u>are required and available online.</u>
- **IHSAA Credentials:** Please apply for credentials ahead of all state tournament events through the IHSAA's Media page once qualifiers are set and event information is available. Professional media can apply HERE. School media representatives (school yearbook, newspaper, website, etc.) should apply HERE.
- Radio & Audio Credentials: The lowa High School Sports Network holds audio rights from the IHSAA's state
 wrestling and basketball tournaments. That means all outlets interested in producing radio or audio broadcasts
 from wrestling or basketball should apply for credentials through IHSSN. The IHSAA does not place radio or audio
 outlets on its credential lists for those events. There is no registration or fee required for postseason lead-up
 events, or for the IHSAA's state tournaments in swimming and bowling.
- 2021-22 Purple Credential: This will ensure entry to any of the below state tournament events. We still kindly
 request online registration for state tournament events for security purposes and to streamline entry for you and
 our staff. Please follow the event-specific procedures and registrations as outlined.
