Game Ball Protocol

- Starting with the 2022 postseason, the Wilson GST is the official game ball of the IHSAA playoffs.
- Officials meet with home team coaching staff, recommend to meet with home team first Home team identifies 3 game balls to be used

We are asking home management to somehow mark these footballs as game balls

- o Home1 for "game ball 1" Home2 for "game ball 2"
- o Or some type of marking system to establish them as game balls
- Officials meet with visiting team coaching staff
 Visiting team identifies 3 game balls to be used

 We are aching the visiting team to some how more than the second to be used.

We are asking the visiting team to somehow mark these footballs as game balls

- o Visitor1 for "game ball 1" Visitor2 for "game ball 2"
- o Or some type of marking system to establish them as game balls
- Each team may continue to use their respective game balls until kickoff time
- Each team will be responsible for providing at least two ball boys for their respective "game balls"
- The game balls do not become community property and the game balls should be kept separate for each team.
- If the visiting team coaching staff does not provide Wilson GST footballs for the contest, the home team coaching staff identifies 3 game balls to be used We are asking home management to somehow mark these footballs as game balls
 - o GB1 for "game ball 1" GB2 for "game ball 2"
 - Or some type of marking system to establish them as game balls Allow the home team to keep one of the footballs for use during the pre-game and then provide one game ball to the visiting team to use for pre-game Keep the third football with you
