Good morning, Head Baseball Coaches & AD's -

We're just a little over a month from the start of practice for the 2023 lowa high school baseball season. However, we have a few preseason updates below for baseball head coaches and ADs.

1. Online Rules Meetings

For those that were unable to attend our presentation at the IHSBCA coach's clinic in January, our required 2023 baseball rules meeting is now live and available online as of first thing this morning. All IHSAA rules meetings are hosted through our database at Bound (same as last season). All coaches should have accounts and access already. If you are new to your program or district, please have your AD create and assign an account for you.

After logging into Bound, you can find the rules meeting in two ways:

- Click on the "Activity" feed on your dashboard and select "2023 Baseball Rules Meeting Open"
- Click on the IHSAA logo on the left menu, then under Forms select "2023 Baseball Rules Meeting"

3. Spring Batting Clarification

Some of you have reached out with questions regarding the 5 of the 15 dates opened up to work on all aspects of the game (fielding, base-running, situational, etc.). These 5 dates are designated for program practice <u>ONLY</u>. These cannot be utilized for scrimmages, spring ball, etc.

4. Official Baseball

As a reminder, we are no longer utilizing the Spalding baseball for postseason play. Rather, in conjunction with our baseball advisory committee, we have moved to the Diamond DI-Pro as our official baseball for postseason play. I know most of your programs are already utilizing this ball throughout the season so should be a simple, positive change.
