Bowling Memo:

We hope this finds all of you doing well and your seasons are off to great starts. With the season underway, there are a couple of things that we would like to call your attention to.

Bound: It looks like schools are off to a good start with scores and stats being posted Keep up the good work. As a reminder, the Bound reporting deadlines are on the following dates this season:

Tuesday, December 12 Tuesday, January 9 Tuesday, January 23 Tuesday, February 6

The expectation is that stats for all matches must be posted along with having rosters and schedules updated. If you have any questions or need any help posting information into Bound, contact Madison Melchert at madison@ighsau.org or Chad Elsberry at celsberry@iahsaa.org.

State Qualifying Bowling Sites: We are in need of facilities to host state qualifying bowling meets on February 12th (girls) and February 13th (boys). To date, 30 schools have applied to host. A reminder that host sites receive \$100 from each team each day. We will need four regional sites in Class 3A and 2A state qualifying meets. Eight sites will be needed in Class 1A. The 2A & 3A state qualifying sites should have a minimum of 16 lanes while the 1A sites need a facility that has a minimum of 8 lanes.

If you have not filled out the site availability form yet, it may be done by logging into your Bound account and clicking on the IGHSAU logo located on the far-left column on your Varsity Bound home page. Click on the logo and you will find the link to open "Bowling Site Availabilities," so if you would like to be considered as a state qualifying host, please fill out the availability before December 13th. A reminder that girls state qualifying meets will be Feb. 12th and boys state qualifying meet will be Feb. 13th this season.
