Members of the media and individuals interested in covering the IHSAA's 2024 winter state tournament events should follow instructions listed below. A few notes before diving into the state tournament information...

- **IHSAA Credentials:** Please apply for credentials ahead of IHSAA state tournament events through the <u>Media page</u> once qualifiers are set and event information is available. Professional media can <u>apply HERE</u>. School media representatives (school yearbook, newspaper, website, etc.) should apply HERE.
  - Forms will open the week prior to the event. Forms will close at the times specified.
- **2023-24 Brown Credential:** This will ensure entry to any of the below state tournament events. We still kindly request online registration for state tournament events for security purposes and to streamline entry for you and our staff. Please follow the event-specific procedures and registrations as outlined.
- Radio & Audio Credentials: The lowa High School Sports Network holds audio rights from the IHSAA's state
  wrestling and basketball tournaments. That means all outlets interested in producing radio or audio broadcasts
  from wrestling or basketball should apply for credentials through IHSSN. The IHSAA does not place radio or audio
  outlets on its credential lists for those events. There is no registration or fee required for postseason lead-up
  events, or for the IHSAA's state tournaments in swimming and bowling.
- **Lead-Up Livestreams:** If your outlet is interested in producing video from postseason lead-up events, the IHSAA has a video access procedure in place. Policies, fees, and application forms <u>are required and available online.</u>
- Media Policy Manual: If you have questions about event policies, credentialing, school media, recommendations, etc. please review our digital <u>Media Policy Manual</u>. Two points of emphasis for winter 2024...
  - 1. We do not credential freelance or independent individuals. Credential requests must come from approved media outlets.
  - 2. Photographers credentialed through approved media outlets are not to independently sell photos through commercial or individual outlets (SmugMug, Flickr, Zenfolio, etc.).
