# 2024 IHSAA State Basketball Tournament



March 4-8, Wells Fargo Arena, Des Moines



### MEDIA INFORMATION

#### **MEDIA ACCESS**

- **Entry:** Entry each day will be through the VIP/Media doors on the NW corner of Wells Fargo Arena. Every entry will require security screening through VIP/Media. Once checked in, media members should take the elevator downstairs to the NW tunnel entry.
- **Credentials:** Media members should display the IHSAA's 2023-24 brown credential if they have it. If they do not have the pass, they will receive a temporary credential upon entry. The credential will be required before receiving access to the floor.
- **Regulations:** Credentials have been issued to media members for the sole purpose of providing access to individuals with legitimate working functions for bona fide news outlets. Unauthorized use or sale of these credentials subjects the bearer to ejection from the state tournament and revocation of access rights to their media outlet. Your application for and entry with a state tournament credential indicates your compliance with IHSAA and IHSSN rules and regulations.

#### **MEDIA WORKSPACE**

- Media Center: The media work room is on the left side of the NW hallway on floor level, through the large garage doors on the left.
- Interview Rooms: Coaches and select players will be brought for interviews in the NW hallway as soon as possible after games. Meet with IHSAA staff to coordinate interviews as necessary. No media access is allowed in locker rooms or team warm-up spaces. Do not delay coaches or players on the court or during award ceremonies.
- **Courtside Seating:** The courtside row of tables and chairs are reserved for working professional outlets. Depending on the game, not all outlets may be seated simultaneously, so please be courteous and considerate with space.
- **Photo & TV:** Spaces for sitting and kneeling are marked out on the baselines under baskets. There are also spaces marked on the 100- level concourse for TV cameras with electric and internet hook-ups. No live video is permitted from the arena floor with games in play.

#### **TOURNAMENT RESULTS**

- Statistics: The IHSAA will provide live game statistics and box scores via State Tournament Central at <a href="https://www.iahsaa.org">www.iahsaa.org</a> as available. Paper copies of statistics will be available at halftime and postgame. Please visit the Stat Room in the NW hallway for select copies.
- **All-Tournament Team:** Tournament media provides the voting block for the annual All-Tournament Team selections. Ballots are available in the Stat Room and due by halftime of Friday's championship games.

## **VIDEO & PHOTO POLICIES**

- IHSSN video policies: IHSSN rules and regulations apply for any outlet seeking to post video clips from state tournament events. For more information: <a href="https://www.ihssn.com/media-resources">www.ihssn.com/media-resources</a>.
- Due to IHSSN video policies, live streaming of games is strictly prohibited.
- **IHSAA photo policy:** Photographers credentialed through approved media outlets are not to independently sell photos through commercial or individual outlets (SmugMug, Flickr, Zenfolio, etc.).

#### PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

- By attending this state championship with an IHSAA credential, you are agreeing to abide by professional journalism practices.
- Cheering and demonstrative behavior are **NOT** permitted on the arena floor.
- Credentials and access may not be shared with coaches, parents, friends, children, etc.
- Photographers may not show participants or officials images while an event is still in progress.
- Do not enter locker rooms or student-athlete areas outside of interview spaces.
