

Spring Golf Memo – 4/24/24

- Coaches, please be sure to continue to enter all scores into Bound upon completion of each meet/event!
- Postseason sites will be released on April 24 (today). Look for those on <u>the</u> <u>IHSAA Golf website</u>.
- If you plan to get in a practice round at your Sectional or District site, be sure to contact that course directly to make arrangements. You will have two weeks (including two weekends) to get in a practice.
- The <u>IHSAA Spring Golf Postseason Manual</u> is posted on our website. Be sure to look that over in advance of the Sectional meets. Green fees for the postseason events are \$15 per player, with payments being due by the time you arrive.
- Entry forms for the Sectional meet and District meet are posted on the IHSAA Golf website. Coaches need to be sure to get those completed and submitted to the hosting school's A.D. or coach in a timely manner! The forms are a fillable PDF, so you can type in the names, grades, etc. and then get them submitted 4 days prior to the event.
- The State Golf Championships will be held in Ames on May 20-21. Class 3A will compete at Veenker Memorial Golf Course, Class 2A at Coldwater Golf Links, and Class 1A will compete at Ames Golf & Country Club.
- Hotel reservations for the IHSAA Spring Golf Championships can be made in the Ames area. <u>Hotel reservation information can be found here</u>. Discover Ames is the local visitor's bureau that assists with arranging discounted
