

CHANGE IN SPECTATOR CART RENTAL

One change that is taking place this year at the state meet is spectator cart rental will run directly through the schools. This method of cart allocation was used at last Fall's 4A State Tournament and proved to be a fair and equitable way to divide the available carts.

- Each qualifying team will be given a complimentary cart for the coaches.
- Each individual qualifier coach will also have a cart available to them.
Coaches of individuals, if you plan to walk with your player as opposed to using a cart, let IHSAA know so that the cart may be used elsewhere.
- The IHSAA will place "cart reservation" cards (very limited number) in each coach's packet. It is then the school's responsibility to give their parents/fans the "cart reservation" card which the parent/fan will use to rent the cart from the course inside the pro shop. Each golf site will have several hundred fans and there simply are not enough carts for everyone, so it makes sense for participating schools to delegate who gets a cart.
- Spectators and fans will not reserve carts in advance. The schools will determine which of their spectators will utilize available rental carts (schools may utilize a random draw, a rotation each day, etc).
- No private carts will be allowed. Due to the limited number of carts available, not all players will have a spectator cart available.
